The Old Chequers Inn is situated in the countryside on the bank of the River Lymn and it is just 5 miles away from Skegness. Believed to be the oldest inn in Lincolnshire, The Old Chequers Inn is a listed building. The site is surrounded by fields and there are 3 fishing lakes within walking distance. Entertainment is provided every Friday night along with bank holiday fun days. Children are welcome to come and see the Shetland ponies and rabbits. On-site there is an 'a la carte' restaurant and pub restaurant boasting a brilliant Sunday carvery.

The site hosts tents, touring and static caravans. Toilets, showers and dishwashing facilities are also available.

The beach, the nearest swimming pool and golf course are only 5 miles away.



Croft is a small parish situated just off the main A52 trunk road between Boston and Skegness. It is approximately halfway between Wainfleet and Skegness (*Skegness is only 4 miles away*). Croft is the ideal location for peace and tranquillity with local traditional pubs and country restaurants – very popular for their delicious food! Croft has its own go-cart track which attracts day visitors to the village.

There is a hourly bus service along the A52.
